2019 Car Collisions

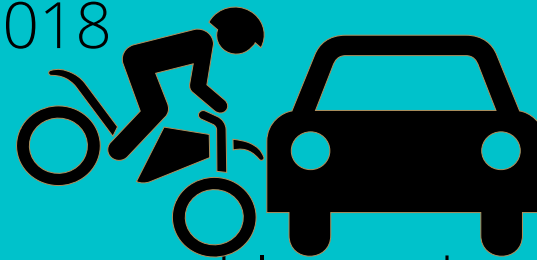
- 285,074 traffic crashes reported
- 1,470 persons killed
- 125,232 persons injured
- 72.7% of all crashes occurred between 7:00 a.m. and 6:59 p.m.
- 25.6% of all fatalities were related to speeding



>4000 Crashes caused by drivers with a BAC over .08

2019 Cycle Collisions

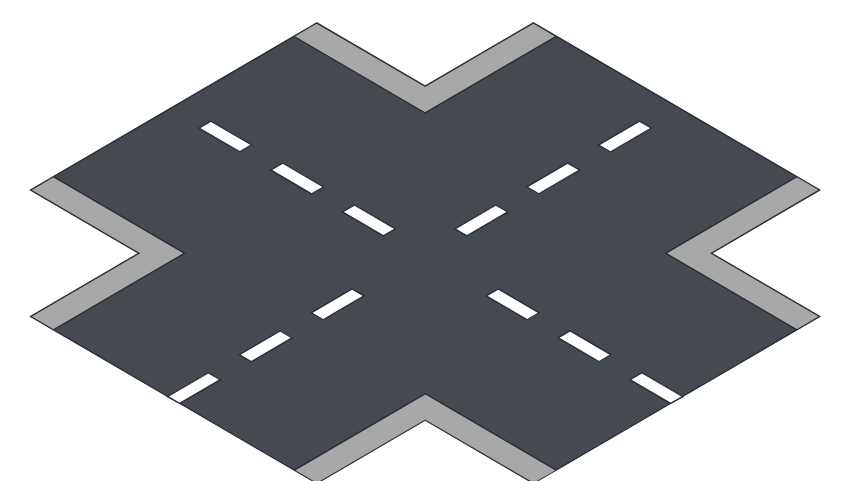
- 183 motorcyclists were killed, an 8.9% increase from 2018
- 2,847 motorcyclists were injured
- 916 moped, motor scooter or motor bikes involved in reportable crashes
- 18 pedal-cyclists* killed



18.8% of Crashes involved Distracted Drivers

2019 Pedestrian Collisions

- 231 pedestrians were killed in motor vehicle crashes
- 10.1% of all pedestrians involved in a motor vehicle crash were killed
